She cannot be part of my small group if she is attending another church; we do not want people to receive mixed doctrine. Was I bad-mouthed for implementing church policy! But God enabled me to forgive her.

July – How can I forget the precious week I spent in beautiful Colorado Springs with 99 women ministering cross-culturally in 52 countries! What a gift from the Lord!

I still remember July 12 when the insurance company told me after one phone call that they decided to pay \$7,500 of my medical bills! Hallelujah!!!

August – After six weeks of rest and dental treatment in Chicago, I flew back to Mexico. Immediately, I noticed the bar we had been praying for God to close, did. Hallelujah!!!
