It is obvious Maria has the spiritual fruit of joy because she met Jesus last November and has been growing steadily since then. She would bring them to my apartment when we have prayer meetings and our small group ended up sharing the gospel to her two little girls, 11 year old (y.o.) and six y.o. Her face beamed with joy seeing her girls pray and listen attentively to Bible stories.

Praise God for enabling me to hang in here in the midst of all forms of spiritual attacks!
